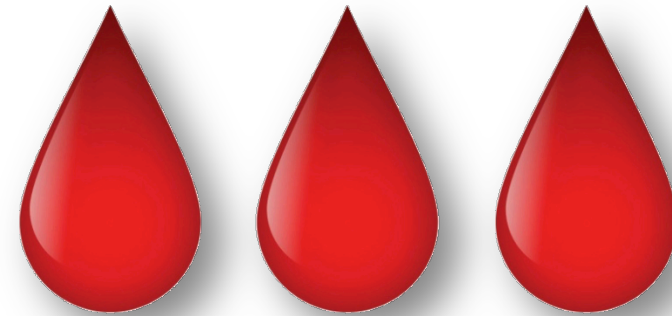

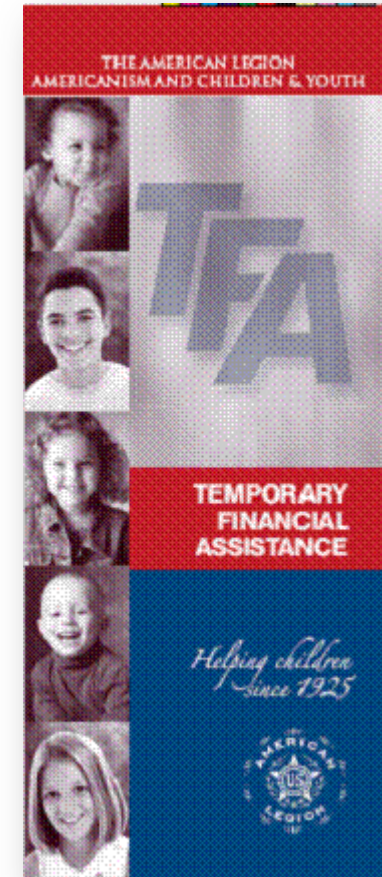

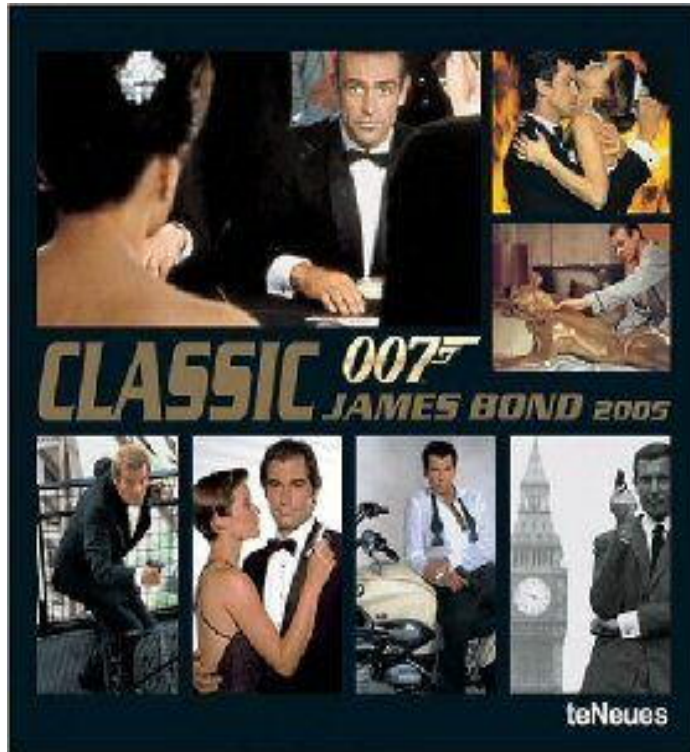

CPR Report

Click **Edit** in each category to enter your Post Report data. After youve completed the form, click the **Save and Submit** button to save changes and submit your file to National Headquarters. After submitting, you can print a copy for your files by clicking on the **Generate PDF** button when it appears. If you discover an error or need to change or add information after submitting the report, you can make the updates and re-submit the form again as long as it done prior to the cut-off on July 1st; it will simply replace the previously submitted report on file. Keep in mind that your Department Headquarters will also receive a copy of each report you submit so make sure your CPR is complete and accurate before you submit it to help minimize confusion.

Please note, you can enter partial data in the report and sign out without completing the entire form, and the data you entered will be saved. This is helpful as you gather information from different officers or leaders by giving you the option to enter the information as its received or waiting until you have it all compiled and completing the CPR in one session.
