July – Military and Veteran Focus on Families Wellness Month

Military and Veteran families often experience unique stressors that can have a profound negative effect on the family as a whole. Family Wellness Month will focus on providing the opportunity for actively serving Wisconsin Military, Wisconsin Veteran and their families to come together and focus on the health and wellness of the family via outdoor recreational activities and the Northwood's Experience here at Camp.

October – Focus on Strong Relationships (Couples)

October at Camp has a romantic feel in the air and what better time for couples to celebrate their relationships. Special Programing

Camp is the host to several special programs and events focusing on health, wellness and recovery for Veterans, Military members and their families. As a host organization we provide, lodging, meals, and recreational opportunities in support of the special programs and events.

Korea & Vietnam Veterans Week

For Veterans who served during either the Korea or Vietnam wars.

Women Veterans Week

For women Military members and Veterans

Vision & Hearing Loss Veterans Week

For Military, Veterans and their families that suffer from vision or hearing loss.

Wisconsin National Guard Service Member and Family Suicide Intervention

This is a three (3) day workshop for both the military member and their families focusing on suicide intervention. It provide the tools and skills to be more ready, willing and able to engage someone that may be at risk of suicide.

PTSD / Combat Moral Injury / Pain University

These programs focus on health and wellness living and they fit our mission here at Camp to "help to heal". The programs help those struggling with PTSD, combat moral injury, or chronic pain. These programs employ holistic and resilience focused skills training and alternative pain management delivered by trained counselors and medical professionals.

Recovery, and Homeless Veteran

These programs work with veterans living with substance addictions or dependency issues and military members, veterans and families who are in a transitional or temporary housing situation, homeless, or at-risk of losing their housing.

Camp Serenity

Camp Serenity is closed to attendees by invite only and is put on by the Wisconsin Army National Guard Survivor outreach Services Program. The program is focused on healing through grief process after losing a family member who was actively serving in any branch of the US military. The families of fallen find peace and safety while sharing their experiences with other families of the fallen.
